Welcome to the Stellenbosch Triennale 2020 curated tour

"Ambitious in scale, the Stellenbosch Triennale offers us a horizon of possibility, a space to dream and imagine anew." – Khanyisile Mbongwa (Chief Curator) & Dr Mike Mavura (Education Director)

The first ever Stellenbosch Triennale will take place in Stellenbosch, Western Cape, South Africa from 11 February to 30 April 2020. Showcasing contemporary art from Africa, this event is set to transform this historic town, already known for its fantastic food, wine and culture, into a world-class modern art experience. 20 artists will be showcasing their works at the Curators' Exhibition and, in addition, there will be music, film, talks, performance pieces around the town, all curated by top local and international names. The theme for the Triennale is "Tomorrow there will be more of us", which is sure to be interpreted in a fascinating and engaging manner by these hand-picked artists.

On top of everything on offer, there is also the once off "DBL WHAMMY" exhibitions of William KENTRIDGE at Zeitz MOCAA museum & Norval Foundation, both on from August 2019 to 23 March 2020. The Cape Town Art Fair (14-16 Feb), IPAF street art fest (12-17 Feb), Design Indaba (26-28 Feb) and the US Woordfees (6-15 March) are also happening during this time.... making coming here from abroad so much more worthwhile.

With this small-group tour, you will not only get a true insider's viewing of Stellenbosch and the Triennale happenings, but also experience the top natural, gourmet and art highlights of the area, including the Mother City, Cape Town.

About your guide

Your specialist guide on this tour is a born and bred Stellenbosch local, with a passion for sharing her love of the natural surrounds and the arts with visitors from near and far. Art & Gardens are of particular interest, and she is deeply excited about how the Triennale will showcase contemporary art from Africa in and around her hometown. The Western Cape is a celebration of natural splendour; its arts, food and wines are created by vibrant and fascinating people who are as passionate as your guide about their craft. This tour has been created specifically to showcase nature, the arts and gastronomy for the traveller who is searching for a unique, inspiring experience.

Tour highlights

The Stellenbosch Triennale 2020 curated tour lasts one week and includes 4 days in Cape Town and 2 days in Stellenbosch.

First up, in Cape Town, you will see the touristic highlights such as Table Mountain and Kirstenbosch National Botanical Garden – both forming part of the Cape Floral Region, which takes up a mere 0.04%



of the world's land area, yet contains an astonishing 3% of its plant species. Visiting this biodiversity hot spot is sure to be a fascinating experience, thanks to your well-informed guide. Stellenberg gardens are also on the list; this heritage estate is a hidden secret and boasts exquisite formal gardens.

You'll also explore Cape Town's vibrant art scene: charming fisherman's village Kalk Bay; gritty Woodstock with its contemporary galleries; Salt River street art & visit crafters to see their work. You'll tour the awe-inspiring, newly opened Zeitz MOCAA, cutting edge Norval Contemporary and the South African National Gallery.

These experiences are all interspersed with lunches at some of the Cape's premier gourmet and wine destinations.

Then it's on to Stellenbosch to experience the installations and performances of the Stellenbosch Triennale first-hand. In between these immersive art experiences, you will also visit some renowned wine farms and restaurants for tastings and tours. Another highlight in your trip is a walking tour of the private sculpture garden of world-famous wildlife sculptor, Dylan Lewis.

Finally, you can choose to add a two-night safari to the end of your tour to complete your South African experience.

Welcome dinner at hotel

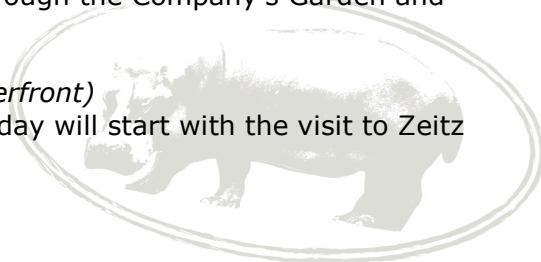
DAY 2: SUNDAY

Best of Cape Town

Trip up Table Mountain* (weather permitting); short walking tour to see indigenous flora at the top of the mountain
Cape Town city tour by vehicle with an informative historical walk through the Company's Garden and visit to the South African National Gallery.
Lunch at Company's Garden/Bree Street
Visit Zeitz MOCAA and Watershed (*or time at leisure at the V&A Waterfront*)

* In case the weather does not permit a trip up Table Mountain, the day will start with the visit to Zeitz MOCAA



DAY 3: MONDAY
South Peninsula

Visit Groote Schuur Estate's or Irma Stern museum or Iziko National Gallery
Drive to picturesque Kalk Bay
Free time to explore Kalk Bay's unique shops and galleries
Wine tasting and lunch at Steenberg Farm
Visit to Norval Foundation to see its art collection

DAY 4: TUESDAY
Gardens & Galleries

Victoria & Alfred Hotel or Cape Grace Hotel

Morning visit to galleries in Woodstock to see contemporary art in Cape Town's gritty, cool neighbourhood.
Lunch in Woodstock: options Pot Luck Club, The Kitchen, Burrata
Afternoon visit to Kirstenbosch National Botanical Garden, with guided walking tour and free time to explore the gardens
Visit Stellenberg gardens for tour of historical estate and gardens

DAY 5: WEDNESDAY

Oude Werf or Lanzerac Hotel

Depart Cape Town and travel to Stellenbosch
Visit Triennale*
Lunch with wine tasting at Delaire Graff Estate and view their art collection
Check in to hotel in Stellenbosch
Time to visit more Triennale events and visit a Stellenbosch art gallery
Optional activity: create and cast your own designed piece

*TRIENNALE: We will visit the different exhibitions spaces that are in close proximity of each other – most of the set exhibitions at The Vault, Pavillion & On the Cusp can be done on foot. Lunch and wine tasting at La Motte and visit Pierneef gallery
Free time in Franschoek
Visit to studio of artist and sculptor Dylan Lewis.
After-hours guided walk with sundowner drinks & snacks thereafter.
Vriesenhof cellar tour and food & wine pairing dinner

Check out and transfer from hotel to Cape Town airport for homebound flight or flight to game reserve.

Optional:

3 day/2 night safari at either Motswari Private Game Reserve in Kruger National Park or Madikwe Safari Lodge in Madikwe.

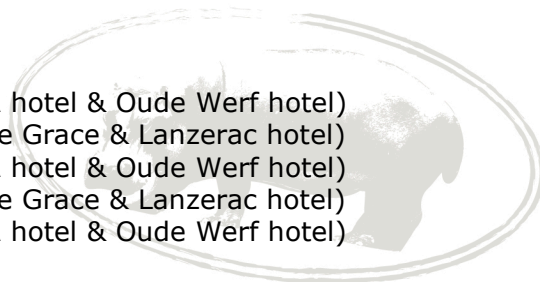
